- 1) Cross Training (begins at 8:39 mins into recording): Yolo Community Care Continuum (YCC)
 - a) Overview of Services
 - i) YCC provides services for individuals with mental illnesses including direct services, advocacy, education, and housing, see their website for more information <https://y3c.org/>
 - ii) YCC creates treatment plans, provides therapy, and independent living skills training
 - iii) Yolo County Programs are Farmhouse Adult Rehabilitative Facility, Farm to Mouth Vocational Program, Haven House Interim Care Program, and Safe Harbor Crisis House
 - iv) In Placer County the Programs are Cornerstone Crisis Residential Facility and Harmony House Adult Residential Facility
 - v) Most referrals come from hospitals or other medical facilities, A4 will follow up with YCC on the referral process for social service providers

- 2) Review Current Advisory Committee Roster
 - a) Advisory Committee reviewed the roster and provided suggestions of what new agencies may be beneficial to the ADRC and how to invite them (Veterans organization, assisted living/SNFs, Russian organization, West Sac. Adult Day Health Center)
 - b) YADRC core partners will divide up suggested agencies and contact them to invite them to the ADRC



3) Agency Updates:

a) Agency on Aging Area 4

- i) Case management department has openings for 2 new case managers
- ii) AAA4 is in the process of choosing a digital platform for agency data and for community care hub creation process
- iii) MOW Yolo will include YADRC flyers into their deliveries in the near future
- iv) CalFresh program continues to assist consumers with CalFresh application over the phone, CalFresh coordinator can also travel to other agency offices in Yolo County

b) Resources for Independent Living

- i) Website is updated and now includes current housing list and assistive technology loan closet inventory
- ii) DOGFIGHT advocacy group continues to meet the 2nd Thursday of each month via Zoom or in person
- iii) Disaster Preparedness grant for Yolo County has expired but RIL can still assist Yolo County residents with disaster preparedness planning and a go bag
- iv) RIL can financially assist with home modifications for individuals with disabilities who are transitioning from hospital/SNF back to their home

c) Yolo Health Aging Alliance

- i) Transportation program is in the process of being created
- ii) YHAA is searching for a new staff member that can assist with installing grab bars in consumer's home
- iii) Nancy suggested collaborations between core partners such as having AAA4 CalFresh program and RIL disaster preparedness coordinator visit community centers

d) Meals on Wheels Yolo

- i) Business as usual, continuing to provide home delivered meals, Cafe Yolo to Go, and congregate meal site services
- ii) Rancho Yolo is no longer a Cafe Yolo to Go meal pick up site

e) 211 Yolo County



- i) 211 can assist individuals with filing their taxes through VITA or AARP
- f) Yolo County Health and Humans Services**
 - i) APS Home Safe Program will be receiving more funding and continue to operate for at least 1-2 more years
 - ii) HHSA branches are restructuring, APS and Public Guardian are now under the umbrella of “Social Services”
- g) Legal Services of Northern CA**
 - i) Business as usual, can continue to assist Yolo County residents with evictions, public benefits etc.
- h) CA Health Collaborative**
 - i) Multipurpose Senior Service program is open for new referrals, applicants must be on MediCal and not have a share of cost
 - ii) CalAIM programs are also open for referrals
 - iii) In the process of creating a behavioral health program
